### Facilities

Suitable classroom with sufficient tables and chairs for candidates and trainer

White wall or projector screen

### Equipment

Unrestricted access is required to a range of lifting equipment, loads and lifting accessories, with authority to use cranes for the duration of the course. Lifting equipment & accessories are to be fully compliant with all statutory requirements, all certification and documentation is to be available for the instructor for the duration of the course. A range of loads, of varying sizes, widths and lengths, including balanced and unbalanced loads, with and without fixed lifting points

Lifting equipment is to be fully compliant with all statutory requirements, all certification and documentation is to be available for the instructor for the duration of the course. Trained crane operators are to be available however trained course personnel may operate the cranes

Electric overhead crane must have an isolator switch that is clearly marked and easily accessible.
