
















Entry and working in confined spaces. Overview

Suitable classroom with sufficient tables and chairs for candidates and trainer

White wall or projector screen

Wipe board and/or flip chart

240 volt electrical supply

Adequate welfare facilities

Confined spaces training/working area, gas detector, complete with current calibration sticker/certificate

GOTCHA (or equivalent) rescue equipment, complete with current operating information, inspection record and certification

DASH compressed air escape breathing apparatus (or equivalent) complete with operating information, current inspection record and certification.

Rescue equipment, including, but not limited to:

Tripod, meeting current legislative and regulative requirements, complete with current inspection report and certificate/tag as appropriate, hoist, meeting current legislative & regulative requirements, complete with current inspection report and certificate.
