INTEGRAL TO OUR OPERATION - SAFER, SMARTER AND GREENER

With responsibility for more than 100 vehicles our Transport Team is an integral part of Harrowden. They manage a range of vehicles from tractors to pick-ups, mules to Moffets and all our drivers and operators. The team is also responsible for organising routes and loads for our own trucks and drivers across the country and for the organisation of national customer deliveries through our transport partners and national pallet networks.

With a fleet comprising 14 DAF trucks, Harrowden vehicles can be seen every day on the UK motorway network as well as travelling locally from farm to depot and depot to you. Each of our trucks is equipped with Moffets allowing us to self-load and unload quickly and efficiently. We aim to keep our trucks and drivers at the forefront of technology and professionalism. Technically we have invested in the *Cubo* system to keep track of our trucks and your turf. It represents state-of-the-art tracking and updates every 60 seconds meaning better information and greater efficiency.

Using 3D 360-degree cameras and a full CAN bus-controlled fuel smart system we can also monitor driver behaviour, traffic conditions and MPG with idling monitoring and cruise control usage helping to inform our training, support a more efficient fleet and improve safety.

We are FORS (Fleet Operator Recognition Scheme) accredited to Silver level. FORS is a voluntary accreditation scheme that demonstrates high-performance and the commitment to industry-leading best practice.

Our team of 17 drivers, schedulers and a dedicated manager have been integral to the achievement of our ISO accreditation.

Overall, the business attained ISO 9001, 14001 and 45001 which reflect the work done across key areas of the

If you decide you would prefer to pick up your order the process is very simple. You can either:





To make your choice easier we offer three types of turf. Our Premium Lawn Turf, our all-purpose turf; our shade-specific turf – Shadesman+ and Species Rich – perfect for creating an informal lawn that is beautiful and pollinator-friendly.

Premium Turf An attractive and durable turf perfect for garden lawns, sports areas and general-purpose landscaping. A carefully blended mix of fine-leafed Perennial Ryegrass, Slender Creeping Red Fescue and Chewing's Fescue.

Grown on premium quality soils from carefully chosen grass seed species, Premium Lawn Turf has a dense, dark green sward that will flatter any garden design from contemporary to cottage-style.

Our unique blend of cultivars have been carefully chosen for their year-round greenness, resistance to disease and visual merit. By selecting seed cultivars that score highly in each area, we ensure a well-balanced and all-round premium turf. We use modern Tetraploid Ryegrass which helps create a future-proof turf – suitable for a range of applications and capable of coping with changing climate conditions.

Premium Turf is strong enough to handle the harsh weather too, meaning that you can rely on your turf in the cold winter months. We strongly recommend using a preturfing fertiliser when installing Premium Turf.

Shadesman+ is a specialist turf variety developed for full shade areas like courtyard gardens, urban areas, and under mature trees. This turf requires 50% less mowing than conventional turf varieties. It has high drought tolerance and can withstand heavy footfall. But this turf will not survive in areas with poor drainage.

Hardwearing, slow-growing and shade-tolerant, Shadesman+ turf is the ideal groundcover for gardens where trees, fences or buildings cast their shadows for part of the day.

Shadesman+ is the result of decades of careful seed selection and plant breeding – it has been refined, improved and domesticated to become a well behaved and beautiful lawn grass.

Shadesman+ turf looks and feels just like a normal lawn but won't lose its colour or its vigour in low light conditions.

Species Rich is a blend of 11 slow growing grasses and 33 native and naturalised wildflowers perfect for creating an informal lawn that is hardwearing, incredibly easy to care for and a real asset to biodiversity.

The result is a multi-coloured carpet of plants just right for relaxing or playing on. Meadowmat® Species Rich only needs mowing every other week. But it won't grow more than ankle height. It's specially designed for a relaxed maintenance regime.

The specially selected grasses ensure full coverage all year round – even in winter. In summer, Meadowmat® Species Rich will keep its colour for longer than a standard grass lawn and will recover from drought much quicker.

Install Meadowmat® Species Rich just like standard lawn turf. It needs to be laid onto prepared soil. Species Rich can tolerate slightly more nutrient rich soils. Please keep your new lawn watered until the roots are well established.

Harrowden Premium Turf is grown for approximately 12 months and is produced without plastic netting. The inclusion of the decade's most significant progress in perennial ryegrass breeding, Tetraploid Ryegrass brings new levels of stress resistance as well as excellent summer and winter greenness. The seed cultivars used are independently selected to provide the best quality sward. This results in a unique blend that produces a finer leaved luxurious but hardwearing lawn. Harrowden Premium Turf will have been treated for weeds and will contain mature grass plants, root fibre and enough soil to maintain the plant during establishment. Each roll should be strong enough to support its own weight when lifted at one end.





Where will you put your meadow?

When deciding on a wildflower area there are a few things to consider.

Turf or Seed – Meadowmat® wildflower turf was invented not just to make it easier and faster to create a new meadow but also to overcome the problems that can come with sowing wildflower seeds. However, if you prefer to sow your meadow, we can supply our seed mixtures as an alternative to laying slabs of established Meadowmat® wildflower turf.

Sunshine – Wildflowers like sunshine. For best results, the ideal spot for a wildflower meadow is an open and sunny spot. The amount of sunlight the area gets will influence how many flowers you will see. In a shady spot you may find you have lots of green growth but very few flowers.

Soil Type – Wildflowers thrive in impoverished soils. If the area you choose has moderate to high levels of nutrition, it's likely you will get lots of green leafy growth and any grasses in the mix will do especially well. This will mean your wildflower area will require more maintenance throughout the season and may not have the diversity of flowers as the plants compete for sunlight.

Access – Once your meadow is established and in full flower you probably won't want to walk across it. Make sure that your location doesn't block off any important access. Pathways can be mown through if required.

Choosing the right soil or substrate

There are five main soil types that occur naturally in the UK and within those categories are quite a few variations. The five main types are:

- sandy and light silty soils
- medium soils
- heavy soils
- chalk and limestone soils
- peaty soils

Sandy soil is easy to drain but doesn't hold on to plant nutrients very well. Heavy clay soil has plenty of plant nutrients but it's difficult to work with and can have drainage issues. Peaty soil is fantastic but if you're buying it in please make sure it's from a sustainable source. A dark coloured soil suggests that it contains lots of organic matter. Organic matter = plant nutrients which means great water holding capacity and lots of worms and microbes to keep soil and plants healthy. To ensure its quality it is wise to only purchase soils that have been tested to BS3882:2015 and have been screened to at least 20mm.

All plants require a good base in which to grow. Understanding their needs will help you to make the right decisions when designing a planting scheme.

Turfing and Grass Seeding

Most of the pain involved around creating a lawn comes in the preparation. Getting a level firm surface to lay turf on is one of the most important parts of a successful lawn. Investing time getting the preparation right will yield results that last a lifetime. Choosing a soil that is fertile, free draining and easy to work with is key for anyone laying a new lawn. Soil quality varies depending on where you are in the UK. The best and most versatile soil is defined as grade 1. Only 2.5% of UK soils are classed by DEFRA as grade 1.

At Harrowden we produce high-quality turf on these soils and we reprocess some of the organic matter from the turf production process to create some of the best topsoil available. Many plants will adapt to the soil they are grown in, taking on the characteristics of that soil and turf is no different. Our turf has a year-round deep green colour. Installing our turf onto rich organic topsoil will ensure it retains that characteristic.

Beds, Borders and General Planting

Raised beds are one of the most convenient ways of growing herbs, vegetables, flowers and fruit. They're accessible, neat and easily managed - you never have to step on the soil. So, no compaction and in theory you won't ever need to dig them over.

the winter months the amount of sunlight available to plants is much less than in the summer. It is essential to make use of all available light during the winter months so a lawn can fight off disease. Using the correct balance of nitrogen can encourage the production of chlorophyll which is essential for photosynthesis. Harrowden Rejuvenator has been formulated to provide the right balance of nutrients for the winter months. Rejuvenator contains 3 active microbes meaning it can also be used as an effective thatch and moss eliminator, helping to improve water penetration, nutrient distribution and root strength.

Feeding Sedum and Green Roofs

Looking after sedum plants is just as important, whether it's at ground level or on a roof. These tiny plants will benefit from a feed once or twice a year. Our specially selected Green Roof Feed provides all the nutrients required for strong healthy plants. Its easy to spot when sedum plants need feeding as they will turn a deep red colour, this shows they are stressed and need some help. We recommend applying sedum feed at least twice per year.

The first application should be in early spring when the last frosts have gone. Your sedum will let you know when it needs feeding or watering. Always try and apply sedum feed to dry plants and then water in well. Sedums are succulents which means they have swollen leaves and stems which store water. To avoid scorching water well after an application of feed to wash the feed off the leaves.





Biodiversity Net Gain (BNG) is a way of creating and enhancing natural habitats. BNG ensures a development has a net positive effect on biodiversity, measured against the pre-development state.



It is important that you know the BNG rules if you are a:

- developer of major developments
- developer of small sites from 2 April 2024
- developer of nationally significant infrastructure projects from late November 2025
- land manager wanting to sell in the BNG market
- local planning authority (LPA)

BNG has been compulsory since February 2024 under Schedule 7A of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (added by Schedule 14 of the Environment Act 2021). Developers must achieve a 10% improvement in BNG. This means a development will create a better natural habitat than before.

Developers should choose and design sites to minimise biodiversity loss. They must achieve at least 10% BNG, as the statutory biodiversity metric shows. Developers have 3 options to reach BNG.

They can enhance biodiversity on-site (inside the development site boundary). This is the preferred option.

If developers cannot achieve all of their BNG on-site, they can do some on-site and some off-site. Developers can either improve biodiversity on their own land outside the development site, or purchase off-site biodiversity units from the market.

If developers cannot do on-site or off-site BNG, they must buy statutory biodiversity credits from the government. This is the last option. The government will use the money to create habitats in England.

Developers can use all three options, but must follow the order. This is the biodiversity gain hierarchy.
