GRASS HEIGHT ON DESPATCH

Harrowden Birds & Bees FLL Meadowmat[®] is a blend of 34 British native wild flowers and 6 naturalised flowers specially selected to be pollinator friendly and beautiful. Many of the species are perennial and will flower every year if the conditions are suitable. Grown on a biodegradable coir blanket, grass species are not necessary in this more colourful Meadowmat[®] which is also suitable for green roof installations. Birds & Bees FLL Meadowmat[®] will contain mature plants, root fibre and enough substrate to maintain the plant during establishment.




