- **GROWTH**
Harrowden Shadesman+ Turf is grown for approximately 18 months and is produced using no plastic netting. The use of Poa Supina and Poa Pratensis creates a medium textured low maintenance lawn, that is shade tolerant and slow growing. Harrowden Shadesman+ Turf will have been treated for weeds and will contain mature grass plants, root fibre and enough soil to maintain the plant during establishment. Each roll should be strong enough to support its own weight when lifted at one end.

Poa Pratensis
- **SOIL CLASSIFICATION** Grown on free draining DEFRA classified grade 1 mineral sand or organic loams.


