■ GROWTH

Harrowden Heritage Seed Mix is a blend of a slow growing grass and 21 native wildflowers that have been selected for their ability to grow in shallow, poor nutrient soils. Most of the species are perennial which means they will flower every year if the conditions are suitable. The specially selected grass ensures year round coverage. Harrowden Heritage Seed Mix was originally designed for green roofing but is just as happy when grown on the ground.

10% Native Grasses: Slender Creeping Red Fescue

90% Native Wildflowers: Birdsfoot Trefoil, Bladder Campion, Clustered Bellflower, Common Poppy, Cornflower, Daisy, Fox and Cubs, Lady's Bedstraw, Maiden Pink, Meadow Saxifrage, Ragged Robin, Sea Campion, Selfheal, Sheep's Bit, Soapwort, Thrift, Viper's Bugloss, Water Avens, Wild Thyme, Yarrow, Yellow Rattle.

■ FLOWERING TIME

Flowers from January to December (dependent on local weather conditions) peak flowering is from June to September.

FEATURES

Biodiverse and pollinator-friendly providing a valuable source of nectar and food for many species of insects and birds.

Contains mainly perennial species to ensure a varied display each year.

Environmentally friendly requiring no fertilisers or pesticides.

A mixture of grass and wildflowers for year round interest.

Low maintenance – does not require regular mowing.

Prefers a neutral pH but can tolerate acidic or alkaline soils - for best results this product requires installation on a low nutrient soil or specialist roofing substrate.

Harrowden makes every effort to ensure wildflower products are free from weeds, however due to the natural way in which these seeds are collected we cannot guarantee they are 100% weed free on delivery. It is unlikely that you will see every species that is listed. The variation of species present has been developed to suit a wide variety of soils and environmental conditions. This will result in a wildflower area that will adapt to individual settings which may mean some species are more successful than others. Contains annual, bi-annual and perennial species.
