

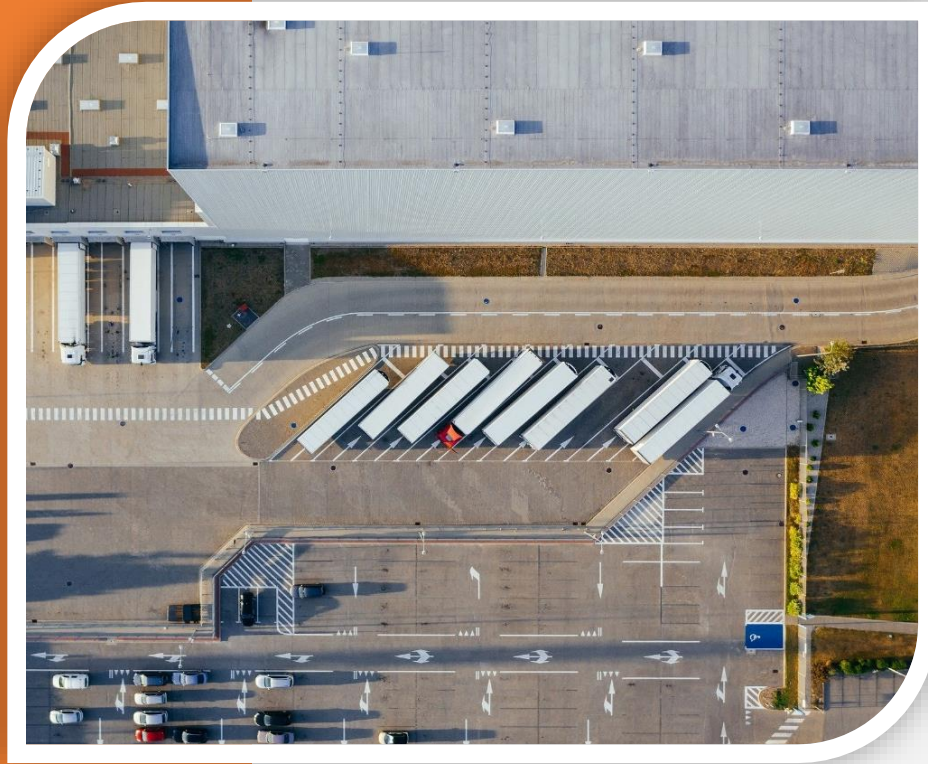

What are Logistic Pager Systems for?

Efficiently controlling the flow of trucks in logistics can result in significant operational gains.

LRS' Logistics Paging Solutions allow logistics operators to immediately notify waiting drivers when it's their turn to approach the docking station, no matter where they are located within and near facility grounds. Using alphanumeric messaging drivers can be informed of exactly when and what dock they are to report to.

LRS Connect for Logistics

Using LRS Connect helps staff to track trucks that are waiting for confirmation on bays. The colour indicators easily show staff on first glance who has been waiting the longest and if they are meeting their goal for the day.



Add their registration number to LRS Connect and hand them a CS Coaster pager and you are able to notify them when a bay is ready.

Using LRS Connect is simple and easy to use. LRS Connect is available on any device all you need is a browser and a working internet connection.

LRS Connect – How it works

Waiting list for lorry's waiting to approach the docking station.

Staff management section for staff paging. (square icons are staff lists)

Once the bay is ready. Staff simply tap notify on LRS Connect and that will recall the driver immediately.

Red outline indicates that the truck has waited over your time limit.

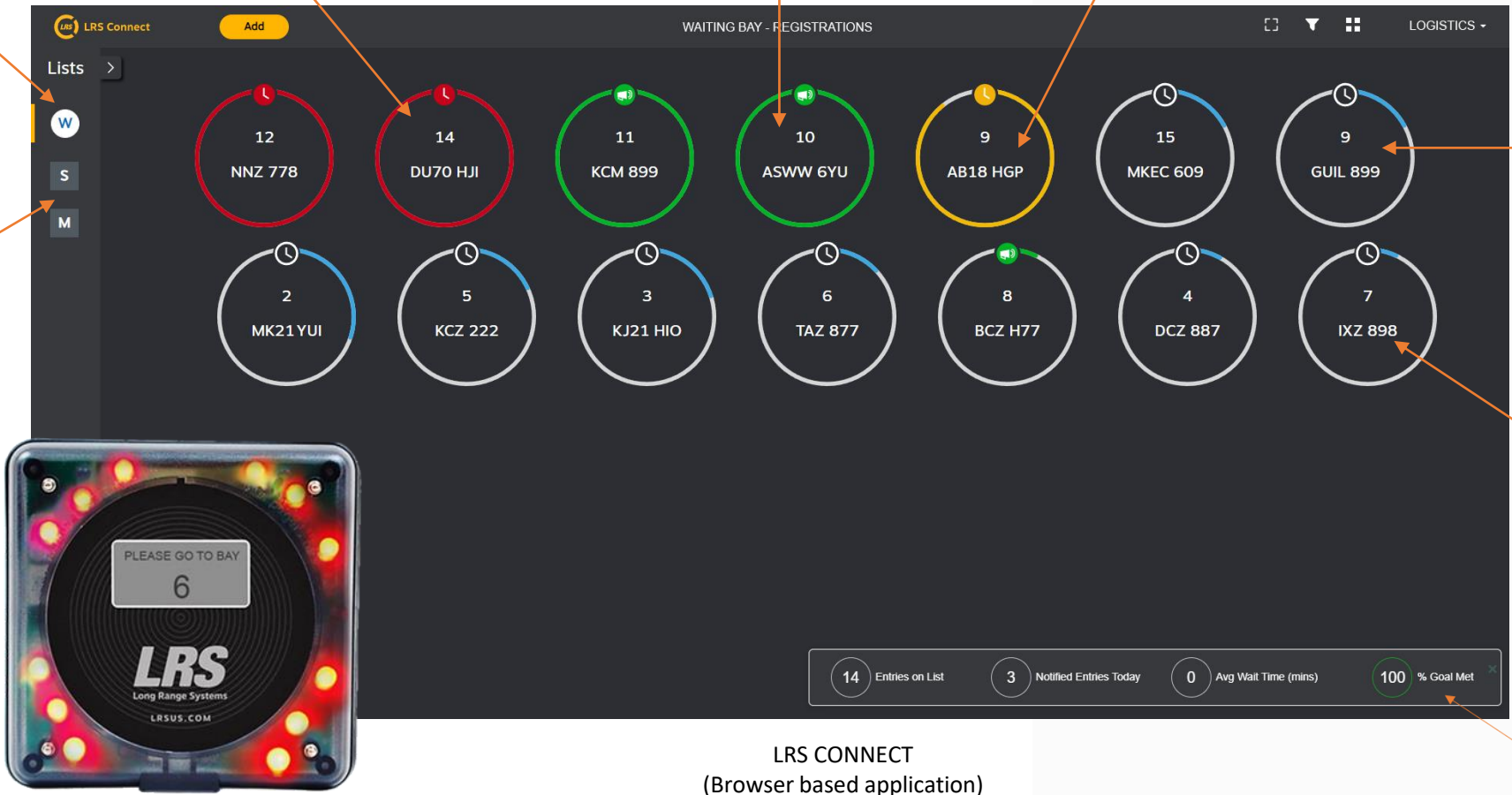
Green outline shows that the truck has been notified (which is removed once they hand the CS Coaster back)

Yellow Outline – Shows that a truck is close to being in the red zone for waiting too long.

The blue outline indicates it had just been entered.

The Registration number of the truck.

Real time statistics of the working day.

Logistics - Emergency Call Points

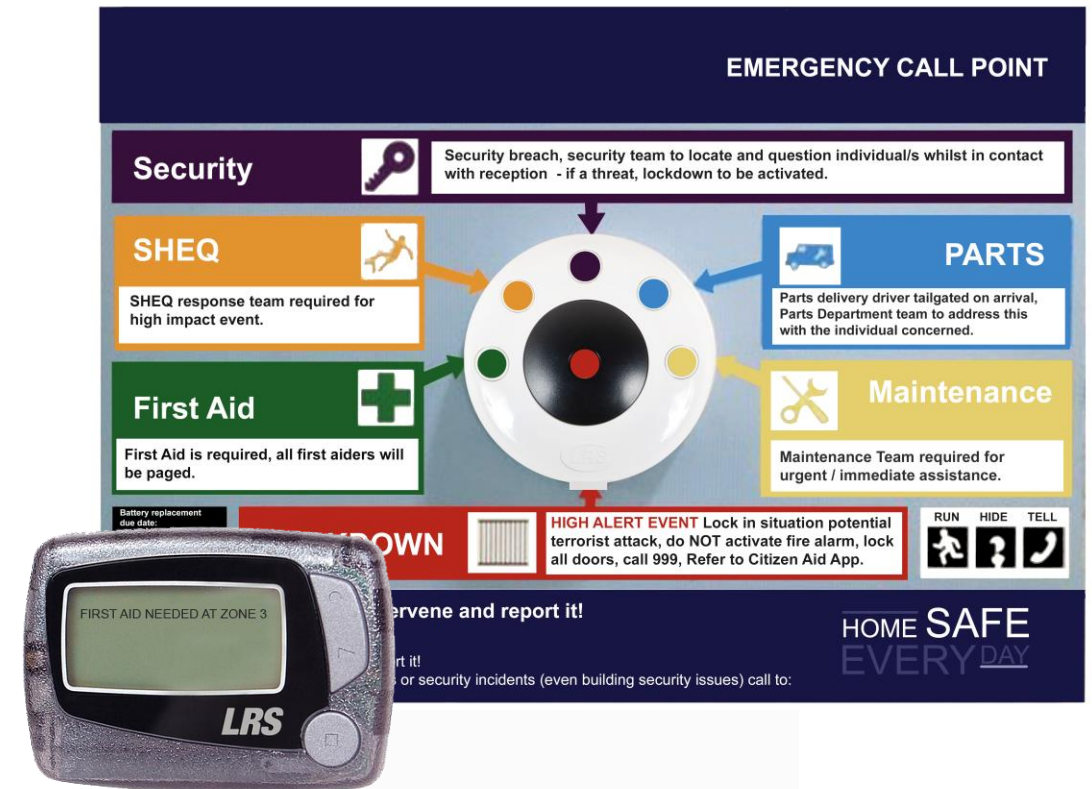
Our emergency call points and call buttons are used throughout the UK for health & safety and first aid solutions.

These emergency systems have been used over and over again here in the UK with great success.

The emergency call buttons can be wall mounted onto boards that allow the user to press the button of the department that they are requesting.

There are plans to include the LRS Pronto call button to produce valuable data that can report when the call button was pressed and exactly how long it took for someone to respond to the call.

It would also be possible for example to see via a report which calls were downgraded to stand down calls and which ones remained high level emergencies.
