All professional HGV and PCV drivers must complete 35 hours of periodic CPC training every 5 years to maintain their Driver Qualification Card (DQC). Without a valid DQC, you cannot legally drive professionally. GS Driver Training offers flexible periodic training sessions to fit around your work schedule.

What Is Driver CPC Periodic Training?



What is it?

Driver CPC Periodic Training is mandatory continuing professional development for all professional LGV and PCV drivers. It consists of 35 hours of approved training completed within each 5-year period.



Is it a legal requirement?

Yes. Under EU Directive 2003/59 (retained in UK law post-Brexit), all professional HGV and bus drivers must hold a valid DQC. Driving without one is an offence.



What does it cover?

Training can cover a wide range of topics including safe and fuel-efficient driving, health and safety, customer service, dangerous goods awareness, and first aid.



How is it structured?

Training is delivered in 7-hour sessions (one day = 7 hours). You need 5 sessions (35 hours) in total over your 5-year cycle. Sessions can be spread across the 5 years.



What do I receive?

After each session, your training is recorded on the DVSA system and a JAUPC certificate is issued. Your DQC is renewed automatically when 35 hours are complete.



When do I need to complete it?

Check the expiry date on your DQC. You must complete all 35 hours before that date. Do not leave it to the last minute — popular sessions book up quickly.



Check your DQC expiry date now

Your DQC expiry date is printed on the back of your driving licence. If it expires before you complete your 35 hours, you will not be able to drive professionally until it is renewed. Contact GS today to book your remaining hours.

Question	Answer
How many hours do I need?	35 hours per 5-year cycle
How long is each session?	7 hours (one full day)
How many sessions do I need?	5 sessions of 7 hours each
Can I spread sessions over 5 years?	Yes — any combination across the cycle
What if I miss my deadline?	Your DQC expires — you cannot drive professionally
How do I check my hours?	gov.uk/check-your-driver-cpc-periodic-training-hours
Who needs periodic CPC?	All professional LGV and PCV drivers
Does it apply to C1 drivers?	Only if driving for hire or reward (paid work)
What is a JAUPC certificate?	The official record of your training session
How soon is training recorded?	Within 5 working days on DVSA system
Cost per day at GS?	£100–£150 per driver
Group discounts available?	Yes — contact GS for employer rates
