Keeping Your Business Compliant

Driver training is not just about skills — it is a legal and regulatory requirement. Here is what employers need to know.



Driver CPC — Legal Requirement

All professional HGV and PCV drivers must hold a valid DQC (Driver Qualification Card). Employing a driver without a valid DQC exposes your business to prosecution and insurance risk.



Operator Licence Obligations

Standard and restricted operator licence holders have a duty to ensure drivers are properly licensed and trained. DVSA enforcement officers check driver records during roadside inspections.



DVSA Compliance Checks

DVSA can check driver licence status, CPC hours, and tachograph records at any time. Non-compliance can result in fines, prohibition notices, and operator licence review.



Record Keeping

Employers should maintain training records for all drivers. GS provides attendance records and JAUPPT certificates after every CPC session for your compliance files.



Insurance Implications

Drivers without valid licences or CPC may not be covered by your fleet insurance policy. Check your policy terms and ensure all drivers are fully licensed.



CITB Levy Funding

Construction industry employers paying the CITB levy may be able to claim grants towards driver training costs. Check citb.co.uk for current grant rates.
