Training for articulated vehicles

Category C+E covers Category C vehicles towing a trailer over 750 kg maximum authorised mass. GS Driver Training provides practical preparation for the relevant DVSA tests using articulated training vehicles.

Who this may suit

- ✓ Drivers progressing to articulated vehicles
- ✓ People who already hold, or are applying for, the correct provisional entitlement
- ✓ Professional drivers checking whether Driver CPC also applies

What the training covers

- ✓ Vehicle safety checks and safe cab routines

- ✓ Off-road manoeuvring and on-road test preparation

- 1 Check the categories and restriction codes already shown on your driving licence.
- 2 Confirm the current provisional-entitlement, medical and theory-test steps that apply to you.
- 3 Discuss your experience with the training team so an appropriate training plan can be selected.
- 4 Complete practical training and the relevant DVSA tests.
- 5 If you will drive professionally, confirm whether initial or periodic Driver CPC is required.

Important

The current licence route depends on your existing entitlements and circumstances. Category C+E is the current official category name; "Class 1" remains a widely used industry term.

Before you book

Have your photocard licence available. Tell the team about any current HGV entitlement, theory-test results, Driver CPC status and recent driving experience so the correct route can be checked.
