



HGV Class 2 (Category C)

Training for rigid goods vehicles

Category C covers vehicles over 3,500 kg maximum authorised mass with a trailer up to 750 kg. GS Driver Training provides practical training for rigid goods vehicles and preparation for the relevant DVSA tests.

Who this may suit

- ✓ New entrants planning to drive rigid goods vehicles
- ✓ Drivers moving from Category B or C1 to larger vehicles
- ✓ Professional drivers checking the full Driver CPC route

What the training covers

- ✓ Daily vehicle checks and safe preparation
- ✓ Rigid-vehicle control, positioning and road awareness
- ✓ Manoeuvring, independent driving and practical-test preparation

Plan your route

GS DRIVER TRAINING

- 1 Check that you hold a full car licence and review your current entitlements.
- 2 Apply for the correct provisional entitlement and complete the medical process if required.
- 3 Pass the theory and hazard-perception elements that apply to your route.
- 4 Select a practical training plan based on your experience and readiness.
- 5 Complete the relevant DVSA practical tests and any Driver CPC elements needed for professional driving.

Important

"Class 2" is the common industry name for Category C. Licence, medical, theory and Driver CPC requirements vary according to your history and intended use.

Choosing training hours

Course duration should reflect your experience, assessment and test-readiness. Ask for a route review rather than choosing solely by the lowest number of hours.
