Making your laundry processes more cost effective

By ensuring that your towels are put on a cooling cycle will help to lower the temperature of the towels and so help to speed up the cooling process. The heat that is retained within a towel can mean that the temperature is far higher than is safe for towels that have been impregnated with excessive amount of oils and fat. For the very best results allow the towels to run on a cooling drying cycle and then remove and fold them immediately.
