



Timber specification

Redwood – is imported from Europe, predominantly Scandinavia and Russia (when grown in the UK it is known as Scots Pine). When purchasing Redwood we specify Upper Gulf 'unsorted', this being the best grade available. Upper Gulf means the Northern part of Sweden (it is much colder therefore the timber grows much slower giving the timber a tighter, closer grain).

Sapele- is imported from West Africa, the timber named after the port of Sapele, which is on the Benin River in Nigeria where the timber is shipped from.

Iroko- is again imported from West Africa, ranging from the Ivory Coast to Angola; it is sometimes likened to Teak, albeit coarser in texture and a little lighter in colour.

European Oak – can be found anywhere in Europe but our main supply is imported from France and Italy. We purchase only the Prime Grade Qf1a for all our joinery products.


All the above timbers are purchased Kiln Dried.

Beam Grade Oak - Used for all our Oak fence posts rails and railings, this material is purchased weekly and brought in from France, Italy and Germany. It is cut to our required sizes on the continent and is still 'green' containing approximately 90% moisture content. The weight is approximately 62lbs per cubic foot. Durability classification is durable.

Note: this timber is subject to shrinkage and shaking (splitting) but does not detract from its strength (take note of all the Oak beams you see in the pub), the shaking is mainly in the bigger sections i.e. the posts.

Note: Durability is the amount of time untreated timber will last outside and in direct contact with the ground



All items can be purchased separately, however, we have also, for simplicity and ease of ordering, created packs to cover a run of 8 ft (2440mm), centre of post to centre of post:

CONCEALED PACK - where the posts effectively stand behind the picket run and become 'lost' on the one viewing side.


INTEGRAL PACK - where the posts are on view and become part of the picket run

Both of these construction options are available in a selection of our own picket profile designs, however we do carry out bespoke work so if you do have a particular requirement, please do talk to us – if anyone can do it, we certainly can!

Concealed post packs consist of 1 or 2 posts, 2 horizontal rails & 23 vertical railings (giving spacing's of approximately 37mm).

For continuation of a fence, 1 post packs are available. ie: if a fence is 40 ft long, you would need 1 x 2 post pack & 4 x 1 post packs.

Please note: Integral post packs calculate as above but with the exception of the vertical railings where only 22 of are supplied (they still give the same run length of 2440mm).


