Confidential data is collected by our uniformed and security vetted staff in a range of satellite tracked and secure vehicles. The data is returned to one of our destruction centres, where it is unloaded inside a high security warehouse and shredded on the same day. The shredded material is then baled and sent to a paper mill to be recycled into paper or tissue products, depending on the grade.

Our secure collection vehicle visits your site



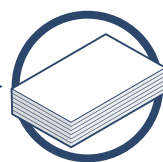
The material is taken to our secure destruction site and shredded



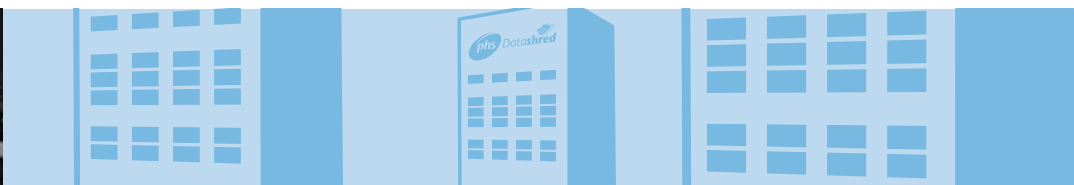
A Certificate of Destruction is issued
