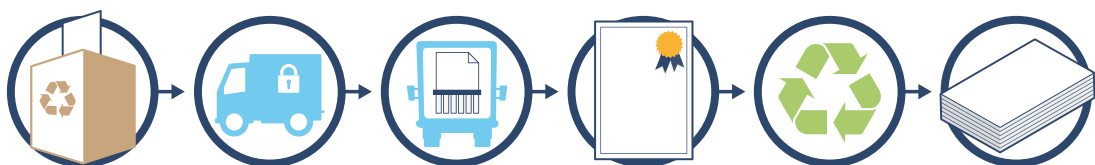
Designed to give peace of mind to customers dealing with highly sensitive information, the service provides an immediate solution with an enhanced level of security.

including staff-vetting, vehicle security and documentation, meet the very highest industry standards and that your confidential information is dealt with securely from “cradle to grave”.

Confidential data is shredded on-site by our uniformed and security vetted staff, in one of our self-contained mobile shredding vehicles. The shredded paper is then baled at one of our depots and then sent to a paper mill to be recycled into paper or tissue products, depending on grade.

Confidential material is collected in a secure container on your site

Our secure mobile shredding vehicle visits your site

The material is shredded in the vehicle

A Certificate of Destruction is issued

The paper is taken to a paper mill and recycled

New paper is made which you can buy to close the recycling loop

Your Legal Obligations

As a company, you handle confidential information on a daily basis, and are entrusted by your staff, customers and suppliers to protect this information. The seventh principle of the Data Protection Act 1998 also places a legal duty on businesses to protect confidential information, with unlimited fines for those who fail to do so. This includes all methods of information storage, and not just paper documents.

If a breach in security does occur, the Information Commissioner’s Office (ICO) has the authority to impose a fine of up to £500,000 in the instance of non-compliance with the Data Protection Act.
