YOUR LEGAL OBLIGATION

The WEEE Directive places a legal duty on businesses to ensure that their redundant IT and electrical equipment is recycled. It has been designed to ensure that the millions of tonnes of waste electronic equipment produced every year does not end up in landfill.

By placing the legal obligation on the waste producer to ensure that redundant electronic waste is re-used or recycled wherever possible, the WEEE Directive is designed to force both businesses and consumers to examine the amount of waste they produce and embrace waste minimisation and recycling programmes. Under this broad legislation, items as diverse as mainframe computers, toasters, mobile phones and refrigerators have to be separated from normal waste and marked for recycling or re-use.
