## Aluminium Edge

Throughout the UK with budgets being cut then a lot of old sports pitches and play areas are being renovated as opposed to new build and as the existing surfacing is flush to the edge then this can be a problem.

A chase cut can be carried out and new wet pour surfacing ramped down to the existing edge but this gives the perimeter a gradient surfacing area and an alternative to this is the aluminium edge detailed in the pictures.

A new aluminium edge can be fixed by drilling 5mm holes with a 18V cordless hammer drill, plug inserted and 40mm screw fixed so that the new [sports surfaces](#) can be simply overlaid and installed up to the new edge. Re grading of spoil on turf on the external edges can easily be done, to remove any trip points.

This gives a constant level playing surface throughout the whole area and is best practice if it can fit within budget which make it ideal for wetpour, synthetic turf, [polymeric surfacing](#) and sports surfaces.
