

Long Jump Landing Pit

Long Jump Landing Pit construction can vary dependent of level of use and ground conditions.

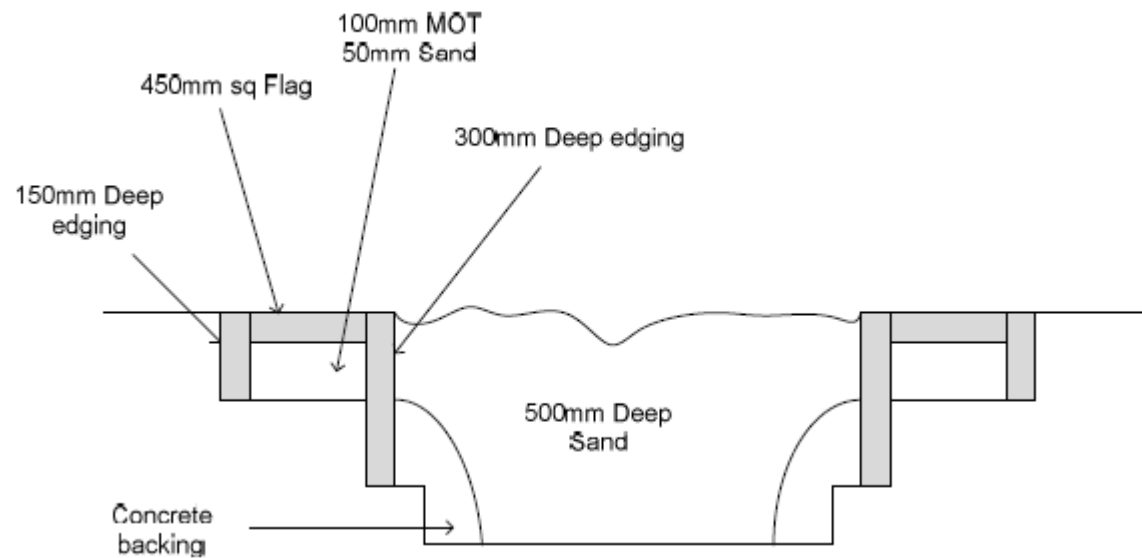
To meet the International Association of Athletics Federation (IAAF) or UK Athletics (UKA) there are certain standards to be met like the depth and size of the [long jump landing pit](#). However should this be for recreational use at a school then the depth and size can be anything within reason to fit budgets and size restrictions on site.

To meet the standards of UK athletics they stipulate : 9m x 3m x 500mm depth.

Minimum standards for recreational use would be : 6m x 3m x 300mm depth.

The mowing strip is an extra over option that finishes the project off to make it aesthetically pleasing and usually laid in concrete flags or [rubber surfacing](#).
